STUDENT GUIDELINES

- Students attending Universal's Grad Bash have a responsibility to:
 - Treat others with respect and honesty
 - Remain in approved attire throughout the event (see Dress Code Guidelines)
 - Conduct themselves in a manner which will not interfere with other guests
 - Report any hazardous or dangerous situation to an adult or Universal Orlando Team Member
- Students must not:
 - Possess or distribute any prohibited materials, such as drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, cigarettes and all tobacco products, weapons, or any gang-related item
 - Fight or engage in horseplay
 - Harass others for any reason
 - Chant school or city names, area codes, etc.

SECURITY

- When entering Grad Bash, both students and chaperones will go through a security check which includes passing through a metal detector. Security will also be screening students and chaperones for the following prohibited items:
 - Alcohol
 - Illegal drugs
 - Cigarettes or tobacco items
 - Weapons
 - Any chains, spiked collars and spiked belts
 - Any accessories that may be used as weapons
- All unauthorized items will be confiscated by Universal Orlando® Security.
 - Any prescription medication must be checked into Health Services (First Aid) once you are in the main theme parks. Over-the-counter medication should be left at school or on the bus. Any medication that is not in a prescription bottle (i.e. loose pills) with student's name will be confiscated by Universal Orlando Security.



DRESS CODE

GIRLS

- Dresses, skirts, capris or shorts
- Casual pants (including jeans)
- Casual blouses and tops
- Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots and flip-flops)
- Purses under the size of 8.5" x 11" and fanny packs

GUYS

- Casual pants or shorts (including khakis and jeans)
- Shirts with sleeves (polos, dress and t-shirts)
- Comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, boots and flip-flops)

CHAPERONES

- Large backpacks

NOT OK

UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

- Clothing with holes or shredding
- Clothing with obscene, offensive language or graphics
- Visible undergarments
- Tank tops or undershirts
- Clothing that exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate at a school function (e.g., bikini tops and bottoms)
- Short shorts
- Area codes displayed on clothing
- Accessories such as chains, spiked collars or studded/spiked belts
- High School, College and Professional team name or logos
- Hats

***Universal Orlando reserves the right to refuse entry into the event or require the purchase of appropriate clothing for non-compliance with the dress code.**
